<b>Course Title</b>	Fashion Beading and Embroidery

<b>Duration in Weeks</b>	5		
<b>Brief Description of Course</b>	<p>This course is for you if you would like to learn how to embellish garments or accessories with beads and thread in order to make them a unique special piece.</p> <p>During the course you will firstly practice on a series of samples that you can keep as a reference tool. As the course progresses, so will your library of samples and reference to techniques.</p> <p>You will explore embellishing with beads, sequins and embroidery thread and techniques such as beaded fringes, couching and French beaded flowers.</p> <p>By the end of the course you will have learnt enough techniques and developed your hand sewing skills to turn everyday garments into some very special pieces.</p>

<b>Equipment Required What will I need to bring to class?</b>	We will provide all the basic materials but you will need a garment or an accessory to embellish.		
<b>What courses can I go on to?</b>	<p>You can continue with the course to progress your own work.</p> <p>You will have the opportunity to discuss with your tutor your individual progression route. Your tutor will help you research other courses in and outside of Idea Store Learning.</p>		

### What examination or assessment will there be and what will it involve?

At the beginning of the course the tutor will carry out an initial assessment to help identify the level of experience, knowledge or skills in this area.

The tutor will also carry out informal assessments to check your understanding, **there is no exam.**

You will complete a self-assessment at the beginning, middle and end of the course.

Your tutor will let you know how you are getting on throughout the course to you will help you work to your full potential.

At the end of the course you will receive written feedback.

### How will I know I am making progress?

You will have an 'Individual Learning Plan' where the course learning outcomes are shown and where you can set individual learning goals and monitor your own progress against these.

You will need to evaluate your own progress and manage your time.

Your tutor will give ongoing feedback and will keep you informed of your progress.
