Brief Description of Course	This course aims to build your confidence in reading with your child and give you activities to help your child's development in Reading Skills. You will practise different activities to take home and do with your children as well as create different props to use to help tell the story.		
Entry Requirements	Everyone is welcome to join this course. Although you will have to undertake an assessment during the course to assess your level of reading.

Please remember if you miss 3 classes in a row, you will lose your place on the course. When attending class, you must bring to class all equipment to study (pens, paper, dictionary etc).

You must do your homework and any other tasks that your tutor asks you to do to enable you to achieve your learning goals. If you do not, then your tutor can remove you from the course.

If you cannot finish the course, you must tell your tutor as soon as possible.
