<b>Brief Description of Course What will the course cover?</b>	This course is suitable if you are interested in learning the basic screen-printing techniques which are suitable to use on fabric.		
<b>Entry Requirements</b>	None.		
<b>Main Learning Outcomes for all Learners (Maximum of 5) By the end of the course you will be able to:</b>			
<b>1</b>	Use a range of screen-printing techniques on fabric.		
<b>2</b>	Use canting tools and brushes to apply wax to fabric.		
<b>3</b>	Use a dark room.		
<b>4</b>	Register and print designs on fabric.		
<b>5</b>	Use professional terminology to describe your samples and calculations in registering print designs.		
<b>Equipment Required What will I need to bring to class?</b>	All materials are provided though you may wish to build up your own art kit as the course progresses. It would also be helpful to wear old clothes as printing can be messy.
