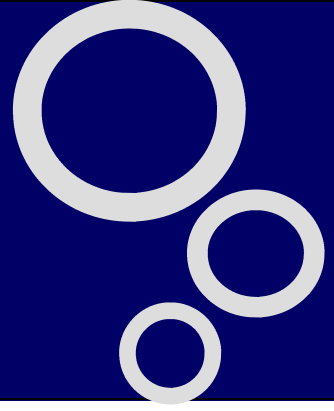

He is inspired by world art, leaflets, magazines and visits to museums around London, especially the British Museum collections.

The selection of work in the exhibition has been made at CityLit, the adult education college in Covent Garden where he currently volunteers as an art workshop assistant on Wednesdays, and at Create, a service for adults with a learning disability, and spans a period of 24 years.

Chris has lived in Tower Hamlets all his life and is proud to be exhibiting his work in places where his friends, family and neighbours can see and celebrate his work. This retrospective exhibition has been touring various galleries and community centres across London, such as Idea Store Watney Market, and Husk Café in Limehouse.
