



## ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS AND RULES

### Your entry

Entries must be submitted by 31 October 2019 at 23:59.

Stories must be a maximum of 3,000 words , minimum of 1,000 words

There is no theme. Stories are welcome in any style or genre.

There are no set layout or presentation requirements, but all entries must be typed, in electronic format.

Entries will be judged anonymously. Please do not put your name on the document.

Entries must be in English (or English dialect).

No amendments may be made after receipt.

Entries must be entirely the work of the entrant.

### Eligibility

Competition entrants must be 16 years old or over on the closing date.

Entrants must live, work or study in Tower Hamlets.

Entrants must be residents of the UK.

Writers who have previously had fiction writing published (print, online, broadcast), or won a fiction writing competition are not eligible to enter.

Writers may not enter more than one story.

Current Idea Store employees are not eligible to enter.

# The Writeidea Prize

## Short Story Competition



### Prizes:

Prizes are:

1st - Mentoring session with Kerry Hudson, author and creative writing teacher.

Runner-up: A free place on an Idea Store Learning Creative Writing course.

Prizes will be awarded at the Writeidea 2018 Festival and will be sent to any finalists who are unable to attend the awards ceremony.

Entries will be judged by a panel.

The finalists and their stories will be published on the Idea Store website in early November 2019. The winner will be announced on the Idea Store website after the award ceremony.

### Other terms:

Entry to the competition implies agreement to have your story published in print form or as a webcast by Writeidea. You also agree to have an excerpt from your story performed at Writeidea Festival on either 16 or 17 November 2019 (date and time to be confirmed).

Entry implies an acceptance of these rules. Entries that do not comply with the entry rules and requirements may be disqualified.

- Please **DO NOT** put your name on your entry.

Entries will be read by the Writeidea 2019 panel, made up of officers and professionals from the library and reading fields. The panel will shortlist the finalists and choose the winner. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
