ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS AND RULES

Your entry

Entries must be submitted to competiton@romanroadlondon.com by **21 May 2018 at 5pm**. Entries must be labelled with the entrant's name and a contact phone number and around 50 words describing their inspiration. Image files must be JPEG with a minimum 300 dpi and not exceed 2MB. Entrants are required to subscribe to the Roman Road LDN newsletter before submitting their photo. We regret that we are unable to accept postal entries.

Eligibility

Competition entrants must be 16 or older on the competition closing date.

Only **one** submission per entrant.

Current Idea Store employees are not eligible to enter.

Prize

The winning entry will receive a 10 week Idea Store photography course voucher, to be used in the following academic year (2018/19).

The Prize will be awarded at the Roman Road Then and Now exhibition launch on Thursday 31 May 2018.

Other Terms

Entry to the competition implies agreement to have work displayed at the Roman Road Then and Now exhibition at Idea Store Bow, on the www.romanroadlondon.com and at Tower Hamlets Local History and Archives.

All images submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them and must not have been published or have won any other photographic competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject, and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any law.

Entry implies acceptance of these rules. Entries that do not comply with the entry rules and requirements may be disqualified.

Administration

Entries will be judged anonymously by a panel of local photography professionals and Roman Road market traders. The panel will shortlist 15 finalists to be displayed at the Roman Road Then and Now exhibition and choose a winner. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

All entrants are invited to attend the launch of the Roman Road Then and Now exhibition at Idea Store Bow.
